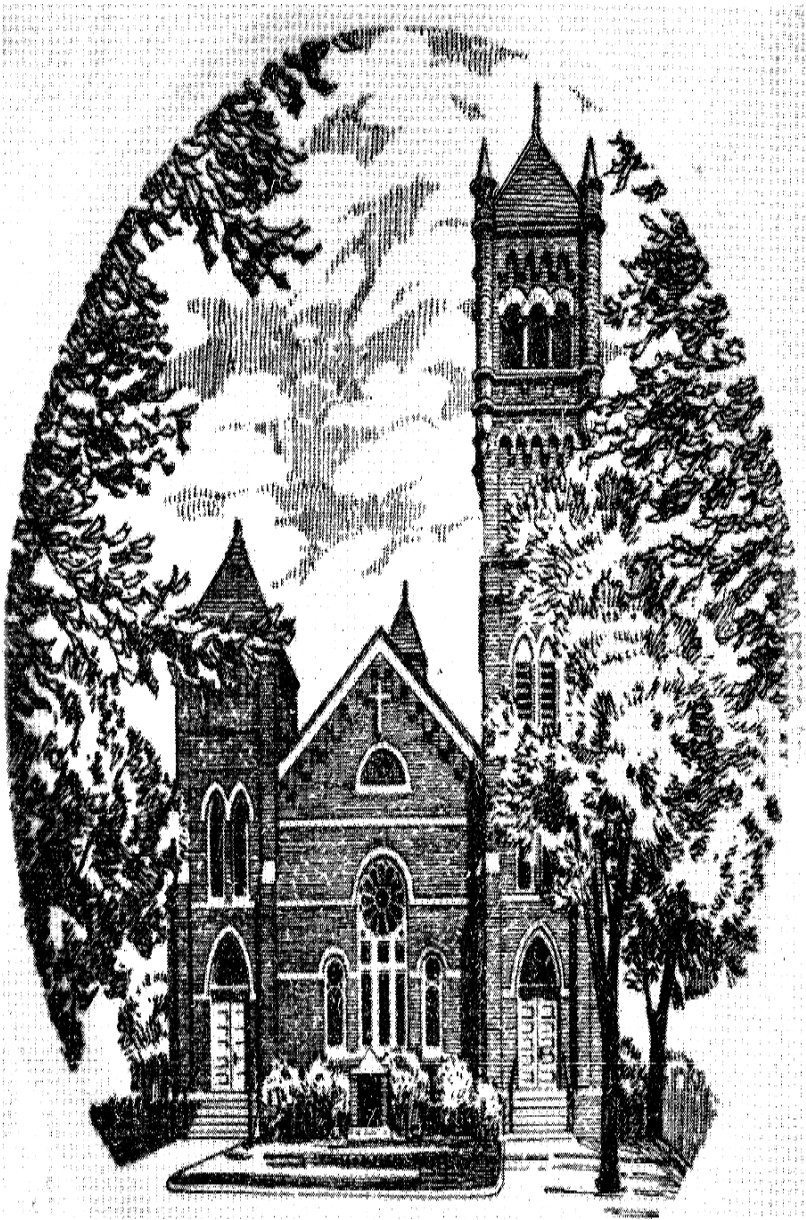

The suggested sites are the area under the cross and flame on the back wall of the church addition and the area where the flag pole is located. However, there would be a cost for the study and presentation of a plan for the Columbarium and Memory Garden. Donations are needed to fund the study and to prepare a plan to present to the congregation. These donations would be used for a Schematic Landscape Master Plan prepared by Brent Skelton Landscape Architect located in Greensboro.
